1. **CB-58-2009** – (County Executive) An Act concerning Supplementary Appropriations of Federal, State and other funds in the amount of \$10,682,603 to the Department of Housing and Community Development, Health Department, Department of Family Services, Office of the State's Attorney, Office of Homeland Security, Fire/EMS Department, Volunteer Fire Department, Police Department and a technical correction to CB-19-2009.
2. **CR-83-2009**-(County Executive) A Resolution concerning a supplementary appropriation of Federal, State, and other funds for the purpose of appropriating funding from grants in the amount of \$482,925 to the Circuit Court, Fire/EMS Department, Department of Family Services and the Health Department.
3. **CB-59-2009**- (County Executive) An Emergency Bill concerning the issuance and sale of General Obligation Qualified School Construction Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$29,638,000.

**4. CR-82-2009**—(County Executive) A Resolution concerning Brandywine Crossing Development District for the purpose of designating a contiguous area within Prince George’s County, Maryland (the “County”) as a “development district” as that term is used in Sections 12-201 through 12,213, inclusive, of the Economic Development Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended (the ”Tax Increment Financing Act”), such development district to be located in an unincorporated area of the County known as Brandywine, Maryland and to be known as the “Brandywine Crossing Development District;” providing for, and determining, various matters in connection with the establishment of a development district, creating a tax increment fund with respect to the development district and allocating certain property taxes with respect to the development district to be paid over to the tax increment fund as provided in the Tax Increment Financing Act; making certain findings and determinations with respect to the tax increment fund and the uses of such fund; providing that special obligation bonds may be issued from time to time pursuant to an ordinance or ordinances enacted in accordance with the Tax Increment Financing Act and secured by the tax increment fund; and generally relating to the Brandywine Crossing Development District.
